COVID Update, Dr. Silvernail	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• As of 6/7/21:• 260 active cases over the last 14 days with 1.4 cases per 1,000 residents (a decrease from last report)• There have been 96 deaths to date but an estimated 98.2 residents recover. Case fatality rate is 0.5• Vaccine Equity is still a focus with only 29% of African Americans Vaccinated (8% behind) and Hispanics estimated at full vaccination• 72,222 have had First Doses of Moderna and Pfizer and 66,857 fully vaccinated	Stay up to date using NCDHHS COVID Website
CHNA Update, Catherine Nelson	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• 748 responses for Pitt County with a disproportionate amount of women participating. Please take surveys to men groups• Race has mostly white participants, black people at about 23%• Most age range is over 55 but participation exists in each age group• Please share and promote the survey using the ad on Facebook, QR Code (in Eng or Spanish) or via email. EQ Review and Follow Up (Thanks to all who participated!!)

- Ideas for onboarding community members: Collaborate with various community groups, more outreach and results in public forums, more advertisements using flyers/posters/newspapers/news/radio, try hours outside of 8:30am, social media, target specific segments of comm. and request participation, recruit students (undergrad/grad), develop intentional pan, personal invitations, walking, continue zoom after world opens, “I’m a partner t-shirts” for new members, Review RBA, Don’t exclude insight or approaches outside of norm
- Are you interested in Results Based Accountability (RBA): 27.8% yes, 22.2% don’t know what it is, 50% need to know more before deciding
- What types of diversity would you like to see involved in PPH: Occupation (more comm. members), (age) more young people, Men, location (outside of Greenville)
- How can we (PPH) help members to share more?: 57% okay with current methods, 10% want less speakers, 15.8% love speakers but want them to have less time, 15.8% want to invite partners to present and share some meetings
- How can we have more gender diversity in coalition: Golf Tournaments, Rotary Club, Current male members invite others, men’s health event. Start Men on Fire group, promote in barber shops, fraternities, sport events, and church groups, reach out to nontraditional groups (PCC), coffee house gathering, BBQ Contest, let men lead conversation
- Is the regular PPH meeting time still ok? 14 yes, 5 would like to see other time options
- What items need better follow through? Signs at Fountain, engaging new members, consistency, provide more action team updates, weekly emails are enough
- 90% of members know that you need to attend 2 consecutive meetings to be a full member, 90% of members know how action teams are selected, 75% want a refresher on PPH, 25% want an orientation
- New ideas for PPH to look into: Intentional ways to evaluate work, annual report, compiling PPH History, Shared and measurable goals, more media, great job!
